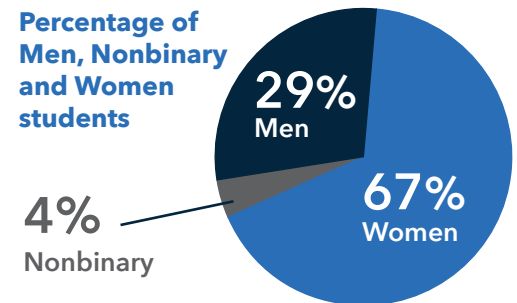

When will HUSL begin accepting applications?

November 1.

When will HUSL begin reviewing applications?

Late November. All prospective students are encouraged to submit and complete their applications as early as possible, but no later than **March 15**. Applications submitted after the deadline may not be reviewed.

When should I take the LSAT?

We recommend you take the LSAT early, allowing as much time as you need to prepare. To be competitive, ideally you will take the LSAT no later than February. Candidates that take the April or June LSAT may be considered, but seats and scholarship funds are likely to be depleted by the time the scores from these administrations are posted by LSAC.

Remember, the LSAT is not a test of your intelligence but a test of your preparedness. The average student that scores at or above the median typically prepares at least 6 months and practices regularly for the exam.

We recommend starting with LSAC's LAWHUB LSAT Prep at <https://www.lsac.org/lSAT/prep>. Your LSAT scores remain on file for 5 years.



Does HUSL provide scholarships?

Yes, HUSL has Merit Scholarships that range from partial to full tuition. Some scholarships are awarded based on the applicant's highest LSAT score and cumulative GPA as calculated by LSAC. Funds are very limited. The priority deadline to apply for scholarships will be posted on the HUSL admissions page.
